Section 720.3053, Florida Statutes, provides for an association that fails to fill vacancies sufficient to constitute a quorum, may apply to the circuit court for the appointment of a receiver to manage the affairs of the association. The association is responsible for the salary of the receiver, court costs and attorneys' fees. That's never a good idea, as it will inevitably take a visible toll on your community.

Anyone who lives in Tracy's Point and is considering volunteering as a director may want to step up and serve. Your participation may have a greater impact than you ever realized.
